

## **Convince your friends to vote!**

- Start by asking a question the brings up the topic of voting:
  - Are you registered?
  - How do you plan to vote?
  - Do you plan to vote by mail?
- Listen actively and identify their key points, then address them empathetically.

If they think their vote doesn't matter, direct them to <u>examples of</u> <u>elections</u> that were determined by only a few votes.

If they feel like they are having a hard time learning about what's on the ballot, direct them to easy ways to get informed, like the <u>Ballot Measure</u> Scorecard or ballotready.org.

- If they are afraid to go to the polls during the pandemic, let them know they can vote by mail.
- Make a promise to follow up to make sure the conversation leads to action!
